Marie Aho, Ph.D.

Current Term: 01/01/2018 – 12/31/2020

Dr. Marie Aho is a native of Marquette. She is a Licensed Clinical Psychologist, Professor, and Academic Department Head of Counseling and Consultation Services at Northern Michigan University. During her career, she has served as Vice President of the Public Sector Division of United Behavioral Health, the Clinical Services Director for an inner city Medicaid hospital system, and the Director of Psychology/Neuropsychology at Hawaii State Hospital. She has worked in Employee Assistance, United Way community programs, child welfare, and substance addiction. She served on the Board of the Marquette-Alger Women's Center. She holds an earned Ph.D. in Clinical Psychology and a Master's degree in Development Psychology.

Ms. Alanko is retired from Cliffs Natural Resources where she was a manager in labor relations and human resources.
