b. Committee of the Whole Recommendation to approve the Sobriety Court Grant.

Board Action: Commissioner Arsenault, moved to approve the Sobriety Court Grant and authorize signature by the Board Chair. Second by Commissioner Wallace. Motion adopted.

c. Committee of the Whole Recommendation regarding Recent MERS Change.

- Bruce Ward, Marquette, announced that the retired/rehired employees offer to pay 50% of the requested FOIA fee.
- Jack Schneider, Marquette, echoed Mr. Ward's comment on the offer to pay 50% of the requested FOIA fee. He also suggested a member from Staff be present at the MERS meeting.

Board Action: Commissioner Wallace moved to direct Civil Counsel to either telephone or send a letter to MERS requesting information she deems appropriate to get answers regarding what triggered the recent rule change including the issue of retroactivity. Second by Commissioner Pellow. After discussion and debate a roll call vote was recorded: 4 Ayes - (Commissioner Bergdahl, Commissioner Cihak, Commissioner Pellow, Chairperson Corkin) to 3 Nays - (Commissioner Arsenault, Commissioner Joseph, Commissioner Wallace). Motion adopted.

12. PUBLIC COMMENT.

Chairperson Corkin opened the meeting for public comment. None was forthcoming.

13. COMMISSIONERS COMMENTS, STAFF COMMENTS AND ANNOUNCEMENTS.

- Commissioner Pellow announced that the State Christmas Tree will be from the U.P. again this year. The tree will be cut down Thursday morning in Republic Township.

- Commissioner Joseph moved to include in the minutes the following Memo from Harley N. Andrews, Chief Civil Counsel/Sawyer, regarding Termination of Employment. Second by Commissioner Wallace. Discussion followed. Motion adopted. Commission Pellow voted no.

Commissioners:

As some of you may already know, I will be terminating my employment with the County at the end of business on Friday, November 12, 2010. For as long as it may take after that date I shall be back in the office, on my own time and at no further expense to the County, to try to bring some sense of organization to the files that have been created during my tenure with the County. For those of you who have seen my office, you know that this will not be an easy task.

I originally retired as your Chief Civil Counsel effective as of May 15, 2009, and subsequently returned to work for the County on a part time basis, with duties limited only to Sawyer. My return to work was motivated by my knowledge of the amount of work that remained to be done at Sawyer, and my belief that my background and institutional knowledge would enable me to provide a benefit to the County by accomplishing that work in an efficient and cost effective manner.

Obviously, four Commissioners do not share that belief. Among other allegations they have continually asserted, in meetings and to the media, that all "rehires" are doing something illegal and unethical; that we are acting in violation of unspecified provisions of the IRS Code and/or regulations; that we are guilty of violating unspecified provisions of the MERS retirement program (despite the repeated assurances from the MERS General Counsel to the contrary); that we are denying other residents of the County the opportunity to hold these jobs; that we are prohibiting the advancement of other County employees; and, that we are responsible for creating a large unfunded liability for the County. In short, they have personally and in collaboration with the Mining Journal editorial staff, actively spread throughout the community their contention that rehires represent a significant liability to the County, and that their continued employment is not in the best interest of the County.

When I became your Chief Civil Counsel in February, 1997, I made the same commitment to this Board that I had made to all of the governmental entities that I had previously represented in my private practice: That I do law, and do not get involved in politics. I have honored that commitment by refraining from responding to the many allegations, accusations and innuendos that have been disseminated relating to the rehire issue. This restraint has been difficult for me, and for my wife and my family, especially because much of what has been said or written has displayed either a willful disregard, or a woeful ignorance, of the facts. It has been suggested that these attacks are not personal. However, when it comes to allegations of violations of law, rules, regulations or ethical standards I take that very personally, especially when those allegations come from a near majority of the members of the body I am trying to effectively represent. I have always tried to adhere to the highest standards of ethics and integrity, both personally and professionally, and to let these allegations go unanswered has allowed a shadow to be cast over my personal and professional life and reputation.

My motivation for returning to work for the County was as explained above. My reason for leaving County employment at this time is not intended, nor should it be construed, as an

admission of any alleged wrongdoing on my part. Neither is it the result of the recent action taken by the MERS board, or the absurd bit of political theater that was interjected into your October 26, 2010 Committee of the Whole meeting. This decision was made prior to either of those events, and was based on the realization that I no longer feel that I want to, or should, work for a nine person Board when four of its members are challenging the legality of my doing so, and believe that as a "rehire" my continued employment is not in the best interest of the County. In taking this step I do not mean to be suggesting that other rehires should do likewise. It is just that at this stage of my life and career I no longer have the desire or willingness to continue working under these conditions.

I am disappointed that my legal and public service careers are ending on this note, but I am satisfied with the effort I have given to the County and the contributions I have made to its mission during the very challenging 13 + years of my employment. I regret, however, that I have not been able to complete the unfinished tasks relating to Sawyer I had hoped to complete during my period of rehire.

Finally, I must reiterate that I am grateful for the privilege and opportunity I have had to work for the County, and with its extremely dedicated and conscientious administrative staff, elected officials and employees, including the rehires. I have nothing but admiration and respect for the work that they do and the professional manner in which they do it. I also want to express my appreciation to those of you Board members who have supported me in my work throughout my tenure with the County.




