Some services offered at the senior centers:

- **Homemaking** – Help with basic, everyday household tasks needed to maintain independent living, such as light cleaning, cooking and laundry.
- **Financial Assistance** – Tax preparation and medical/prescription plan assistance is available.
- **Outreach** — Identifies and contacts older residents in need of assistance, and provides information about available services. Outreach may include referral and service arrangement.
- **Case Coordination and Support** — Long-term client care support services that regularly coordinate services allowing seniors to remain living safely and independently in their homes.
- **Other Case Management Services** — Help is provided to seniors, family members and caregivers experiencing difficulties coping with personal problems, aging issues, illness and other concerns.

Other available services:

Community Action Alger-Marquette— Nutrition Services — Delivers nutritious meals to homebound seniors. Provides meals at congregate meal sites, where older adults can socialize with neighbors.

Retired and Senior Volunteer Program — Provides those 55 and better with the opportunity to volunteer within the community, and offers support to seniors in their homes through medical transportation and visitor programs.

Information about those providing service to Marquette County seniors is available to anyone regardless of age.
