STD TESTING

MCHD offers confidential STD testing and treatment for:

- HIV/AIDS
- Chlamydia
- Gonorrhea
- Syphilis
- Genital Warts

If you believe that you may have been exposed to any STD, make an appointment to see the Nurse Practitioner as soon as possible.

HIV TESTING

HIV testing is offered at MCHD by certified testing counselors:

- HIV testing is \$35.00
- Confidential or anonymous

Services can be billed to insurance or are based on a sliding fee scale by family size and income.


FAMILY PLANNING

- Testing and treatment of sexually transmitted diseases


BREAST AND CERVICAL CANCER SCREENING

This program is offered to women that are between the ages of 40 - 64. Screening services are provided FREE to women who meet federal guidelines, and who are not enrolled in an HMO, prepaid managed care plan or Medicare Part B. Available services:

- Clinical breast exam
 - Mammograms
- Pelvic examination and pap smear
 - Some diagnostic services
 - Notification of results
 - Managed follow up care
 - Patient education
 - Referrals as needed



IMMUNIZATIONS



Immunizations are provided at MCHD at a reasonable cost or can be billed to insurance. Immunizations include:

- DTap and Tdap
- Influenza (Flu)
- Haemophilus Influenzae Type B (HIB)
- Hepatitis A and Hepatitis B
- HPV (Gardasil)
- IPV (Polio)
- MCV4 (Menactra)
- MMR
- Pneumovax (Pneumococcal Polysaccharide) (PPSV23)
- PCV13 (Prevnar-Pneumococcal Conjugate)
- Rotavirus
- TB Skin Test
- Varicella
- Zostavax (Shingles)
