



Marquette County Housing Rehabilitation Program

Pre-Qualification Form



Homeowners interested in funding assistance from the Marquette County Housing Rehabilitation Program must complete a Pre-Qualification Form (PQF) as the first step in the application process. The PQF streamlines the qualifying process by allowing a quick evaluation for the major program requirements. This is done to save the applicant the time and expense of filling out the full application if he/she does not meet the minimum requirements.

Please Note: Pre-Qualifying does not guarantee that an applicant will actually receive funding or that funding is or will be available - it is just a step in the process that can help quickly evaluate whether an applicant is eligible or not.
