

2018 APPOINTMENTS TO VARIOUS BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS OF THE MARQUETTE COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

The Marquette County Board of Commissioners, in an effort to familiarize the public with the various boards and commissions appointed by the County Board provides this summary of the functions, composition and terms of office of each board and commission. The Marquette County Board of Commissions encourages interested and qualified individuals to apply for the available position.

CENTRAL DISPATCH POLICY BOARD

This Board is an 18-member board comprised of one (1) County Commissioner; one (1) representative of the City of Ishpeming; one (1) representative of the City of Marquette; one (1) representative of the City of Negaunee; four (4) representatives of local townships after receipt of recommendations from the MCTA; one (1) citizen at large; one (1) representative of a county police agency; three (3) representatives of county fire departments; three (3) representatives of county emergency medical service groups; one (1) sheriff's representative chosen by the Michigan Sheriff's Association; and one (1) representative appointed by the Michigan State Police. This Board oversees the operation of the Marquette County Central Dispatch Communications System. Terms are three years with the exception of the County Commissioner who shall serve a one-year term.

MARQUETTE COUNTY SOLID WASTE AUTHORITY

The Solid Waste Authority is a seven-member board with three members appointed by the Marquette County Board of Commissioners to staggered 3-year terms. The remaining members are appointed by the City of Marquette (two), one authority appointment, with the Chairperson being from Sands Township. The Authority assumes the responsibilities and obligations, undertakings and disposition for Marquette County municipalities under an Interlocal Agreement for the operation and management of the Solid Waste Management System Facility.

PATHWAYS (COMMUNITY MENTAL HEALTH BOARD)

The Pathways Board governs the operations of the Mental Health Program in Alger, Delta, Luce, and Marquette Counties. The composition of the board includes representatives of providers of mental health recipients or consumers of mental health services, agencies and occupations having a working involvement with mental health services, and the general public. It is a twelve-member body with up to six being public official members and the remainder being private citizens. A public official is defined as someone who works 20 hours or more per week for federal, state, or local government. Six of the appointments are made by the Marquette County Board, four made by the Delta County Board, one by the Alger County Board, and one by the Luce County Board to 3-year terms.

An application must be on file to be considered for appointment by the Marquette County Board of Commissioners. Deadline for Applications is Friday, June 1, 2018.
