Mary Jane also noted that over the same time frame, the percentage of veterans in the senior population will decrease meaning that as the need for services increases, fewer services will be provided by veterans' programs. Mary Jane suggested that it would be helpful to not vary the survey questions too much from the previous one for comparison.
